- 08.30** Pick up at guest hotel (Please be ready 10 minutes before pick up time).
- 09.30** Arrive at **Bang Pa-In Royal Palace**, also known as the Summer Palace, is a historic and beautiful royal residence located in Ayutthaya Province, about 60 kilometers north of Bangkok. The palace is famous for its stunning architecture, which blends Thai, European, and Chinese styles, as well as its beautifully landscaped gardens and serene lakes.
- Then visit **Wat Mahathat**, one of the most significant and historically important temples in Ayutthaya, the ancient capital of Thailand. The temple is located within the Ayutthaya Historical Park, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, and is known for its rich history, impressive architecture, and iconic Buddha head entwined in tree roots.
- 12.00** Lunch at restaurant. Enjoy eating traditional Thai food. (Own expenses)
- After lunch head to **Wat Phra Si Sanphet**, one of the most important and impressive temples in Ayutthaya, the ancient capital of Thailand. It is located within the Ayutthaya Historical Park, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, and is renowned for its magnificent ruins and historical significance. The temple was once the royal monastery and the spiritual heart of the kingdom during the peak of the Ayutthaya period.
- Head to **Ayothaya Floating Market**, a cultural attraction in Ayutthaya that offers a traditional Thai atmosphere with wooden houses, local food, handicrafts, and live historical shows. **Enjoy a boat ride around the market and experience a 10-minute elephant ride.** The market also features scenic photo spots and is easily accessible from Bangkok — making it ideal for a day trip that combines culture, cuisine, and history in one memorable experience.
- 17.30** Head back to hotel.
- 19.00** Hotel drop off.
